LifePoint Academy of Seventh-day Adventist Fees and Tuition Schedule

A \$50 non-refundable application fee is due by February 28, 2023, with each new student application. If the \$50 application fee is received by the February 28, 2023 deadline, the fee will be credited back to the student's account **when the \$300 registration fee is paid by June 1, 2023.**

Tuition payments may be spread out over ten (August – May) or twelve (July – June) months.

Family Discounts*: 5% Second Student, 10% Each Additional Student

Tuition for K through 8th grade includes Books, Subscriptions, Software, and Graduation Fees.

Payment Options

Financial Contracts must be completed and agreed upon before students begin attending school.

Annual Plan*: Full payment of tuition due by August 1, 2023, receive a 3% discount. This payment is payable directly to the school.

Semi-Annual Plan*: Two equal tuition payments due August 1, 2023, and January 2, 2024, receive a 2% discount. Payments made after the deadline will be ineligible for the discount.

Monthly Plan*: Ten or twelve-monthly payments **MUST be made through online payments.** These electronic payments will begin in July or August 2023 and can be withdrawn through FACTS. There is a \$45.00 yearly fee per family for this service.

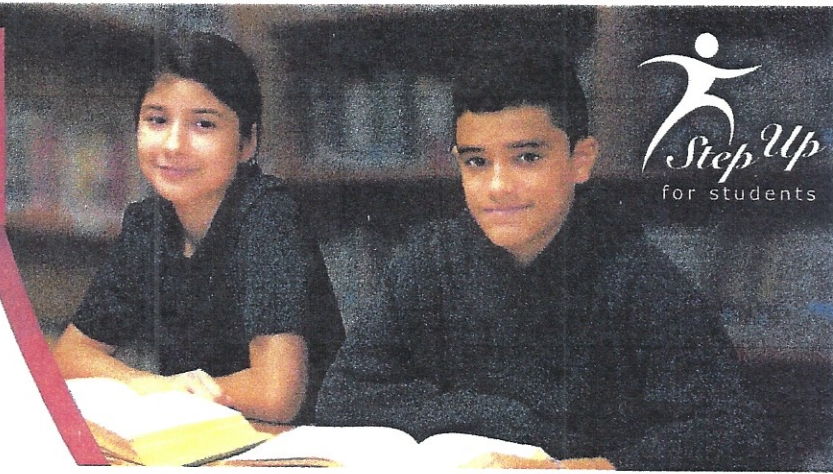
LifePoint Academy accepts the Step Up for Students and McKay Scholarships.

Scholarships for K-12 Students to Attend Private School

The Family Empowerment Scholarship for Educational Options (FES-EO) and the Florida Tax Credit (FTC) Scholarship Program offer scholarships worth on average \$7,000 and cover the cost of private school tuition and fees, books and more.

Who is eligible?

Students in grades K-12* who meet one or more of the following:

- Families can qualify based on household income. For example, a family of four could have an income of up to \$111,000 annually and receive scholarships for their children.
- Dependent children of a reservist or an active-duty member of the United States Armed Forces
- Dependent children of a law enforcement officer
- Children currently in foster or out-of-home care
- Siblings of students participating in the Family Empowerment Scholarship for Students with Unique Abilities

* Students entering kindergarten must be 5 on or before September 1

Scholarships for Students with Unique Abilities

The Family Empowerment Scholarship for Students with Unique Abilities (FES-UA) is worth an average of \$10,400 and covers the cost of private school tuition, instructional materials, home education, tutoring and more.


Who is eligible?

- Students 3 years old to high school graduation or age 22, whichever comes first
- Children with one of 23 diagnoses including, but not limited to: autism spectrum disorder, Down syndrome, spina bifida and emotional, behavioral or intellectual disabilities

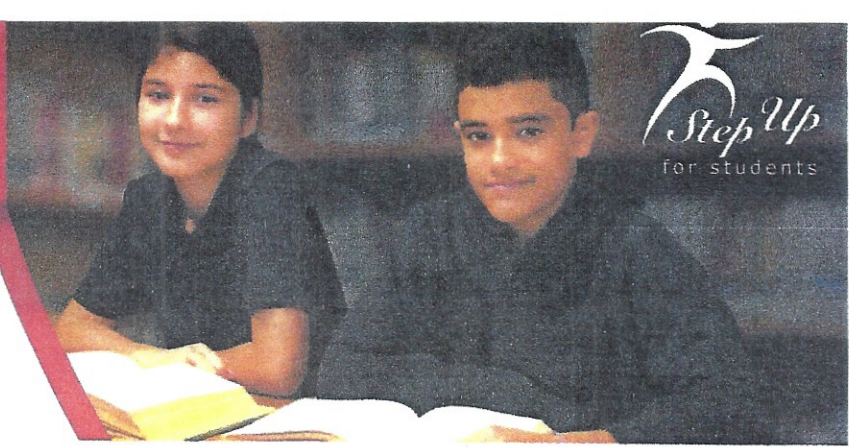

La Beca de Family Empowerment para Opciones Educativas (FES-EO) y el Programa de Becas Florida Tax Credit (FTC) ofrecen becas por un valor promedio de \$7,000 y cubren el costo de matrícula y cuotas de escuelas privadas, libros y más.

¿Quién es elegible?

Estudiantes en los grados K-12* que cumplan con uno o más de los siguientes:

- Las familias pueden calificar según los ingresos del hogar. Por ejemplo, una familia de cuatro miembros podría tener un ingreso de casi \$ 111,000 al año y recibir becas para sus hijos.
- Hijos dependientes de un reservista o un miembro en servicio activo de las Fuerzas Armadas de los Estados Unidos
- Hijos dependientes de un oficial de la ley
- Niños actualmente en cuidado de foster o cuidado fuera del hogar
- Hermanos de estudiantes que participan en la Beca Family Empowerment para estudiantes con necesidades especiales

*Los estudiantes que ingresan a Kindergarten deben tener 5 años para el 1 de septiembre o antes.



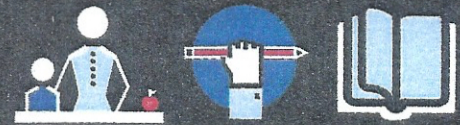
Los fondos del programa para cada beca son limitados y están disponibles por orden de llegada.

La Beca Family Empowerment para Estudiantes con Necesidades Especiales (FES-UA) tiene un valor promedio de \$10,400 y cubre el costo de la matrícula de una escuela privada, materiales de instrucción, educación en el hogar, tutoría y más.


¿Quién es elegible?

- Estudiantes de 3 años a graduarse de la escuela secundaria o 22 años, lo que ocurra primero
- Niños con uno de los 23 diagnósticos que incluyen, entre otros: trastorno del espectro autista, síndrome de Down, espina bífida y discapacidades emocionales, conductuales o intelectuales
